REGULAR MEETING, COMMUNITY ROOM, JUNE 8, 2006**

Mayor John M. "Mike" Davis called the regular meeting of the Village Council to order at 7:30 p.m.

Tyrone Kapp – 2000 Springdale Boulevard, Apt F-212, Palm Springs, Florida. He asked what is the criterion regarding speed bumps. Does the Village pay for it, or is it the responsibility of the neighborhood? There are too many cars speeding and there is no speed bump straight up to Kirk Road from Springdale Boulevard. Village Manager Umberger stated that the Homeowners Association usually pays for the installation of speed bumps but painting of the stripes on the road is the Village’s responsibility.

Mayor Davis explained to Mr. Kapp that he needed to go back to his HOA and try to get a petition with 51 percent or more support for speed bumps and the Council would then be able to take a look at the request.
